- competitors:** TKD-competitors 10th Kup and above, with a valid ETU/WT-membership
- Those who are not recognized as adults by law in their own country must submit a written consent signed by parents or lawful guardian accepting the participation and all parts of the official invitation (liability declaration).
- rules:** The competition rules of the DTU are valid, according to the cut-off-system, with the following modification:
- for individual, pair, synchron:
- number of rounds:
9 competitors and above: 2 rounds (semi-final & final)
1 – 8 competitors: 1 round (final)
 - number of competitors:
semi-final: all competitors
final: 8 best scored competitors



3. Achieved points from the semi-final will not count for the final.
4. number of Poomsae:
semi-final: 1 Poomsae
final: 2 Poomsae, starting with the second Poomsae not later than 1 minute after the end of the first Poomsae
5. A change of the category (age-group/graduation) is not permitted.
6. compulsory Poomsae:
individual LK 1: drawn by lot for each category and published on 25th September 2026 on the TVSH website in the "Termine" section at www.tv-sh.de
individual LK 2 + LK 3: free choice of poomsae defined in this outline
pair & synchron: free choice of poomsae defined in this outline
para: free choice from Taeguk 1 and above
7. All participants in the para divisions must show a medical certificate to prove their disability at the registration. This certificate can be issued in German or English language. If the participant is in possession of a disabled ID card, it needs to be shown as well. INAS Master List is accepted by number.

for breaking:

1. 1 round for all competitors: final.
2. The competitor has to bring his own breaking material.
3. Only single-breaking or combinations with up to 3 techniques are allowed.
4. A combination is a sequence of techniques in which no more than two steps are allowed between the individual techniques and no concentration phase or interruption of the flow of movement between the techniques can be detected.
5. Breaking with the hand is only allowed for competitors older than 18 years.
6. Only wood is allowed, 30 cm x 30 cm.
7. The belt-promotion-rules of the DTU for breaking are valid for the wood thickness. With increased difficulty these can be reduced.
8. All partners who will assist have to wear a dobok.

for freestyle:

1. 1 round for all competitors: final.
2. The music must be sent as an mp3 file until the deadline by e-mail to reg@tvsh-mail.de
3. The freestyle Poomsae shall have a duration:
division under 11: from 60 to 100 seconds
division above 12: from 90 to 100 seconds



for freestyle light:

1. 1 round for all competitors: final.
2. The use of music is voluntary. If music is used, the mp3-file should be sent until the deadline by e-mail to reg@tvsh-mail.de
3. The following basic techniques are mandatory:
twio-ap-chagi, twio-yop-chagi, acrobatic action
4. The freestyle Poomsae shall have a duration from 30 to 100 seconds.
5. If a basic technique is missing it will be sanctioned with -0.3 points.

limit: The online-registration closes on exceeding the limit of competitors. The limit is adjusted variably based on the number of competition areas.

The online-registration also closes when a certain number of starts per club has been reached.

1st place: trophy & certificate

2nd & 3rd place: medal & certificate

pair, synchron, breaking & freestyle

1st – 3rd place: medal + certificate

clubs:

1st – 3rd place: trophy

The award ceremony will take place immediately after the respective contest on the competition area.

scoring:

Places 1 - 3 will be scored for classification of clubs and countries.

The formula 6 - 3 - 1 will be used. For win by default 1 point is given.

coach:

For every start a coach is mandatory. The minimum age is 12 years. A T-shirt or a training jacket, as well as solid, closed-toe shoes, must be worn.

liability:

All competitors participate at their own risk. The registration application implies that the competitors agree to assume responsibility for themselves and to release all others from all and any liability which may directly or indirectly result from the tournament.

data privacy:

The competitors agree with the registration that the results (with the name of the athletes) will be reported on the internet as well as in printed media.

anti-doping:

All competitors accept with the registration the agreement with the NADA/WADA (National & World Antidoping Agency) www.nada.de
